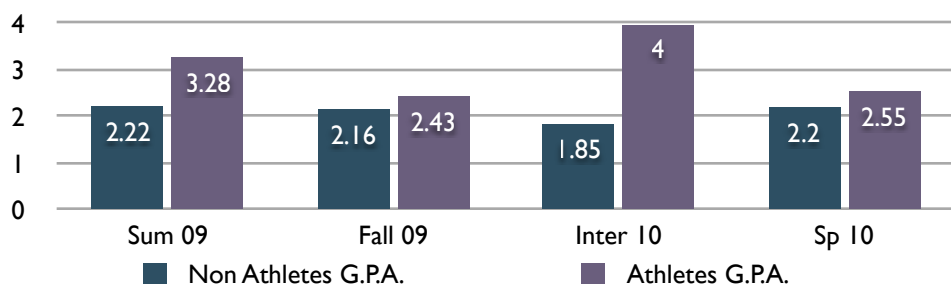
A Message from the Athletic Director
